Covid 19 still continues to spread in Wales and our local area, however we will open on Monday 10th December for face to face learning. (What a relief for us all!)

There will be some additional safety measures in place in school. Below is a reminder and additional information.

COVID 19 School Safety Rules Reminder

- All children will be able to arrive together between 8.40am and 8.55 am. Please arrive on time so teachers on duty can return to class
- Drop off and pick up at the school gate, teachers will meet pupils at the front gates
- All children will finish school together and will be brought down to the gate at 3.20pm
- FP children will eat their lunch in the hall
- KS2 children will eat in their class room
- There will be no assembly in the hall, this will be replaced by class assembly
- Social distancing at the school gates please and masks MUST be worn at the school gate
- Children only need their coats, drinks bottles, snack and lunch and all other equipment will be provided for them.
- PE Kits should be worn on a Monday and Forest School Clothes on a Friday.
- Breakfast Club from 7.45am please use the hall doors for access.
- After School Club will be on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday until 5.20pm and MUST be pre booked. Collection from the hall doors please.
- Children and staff will continue to sanitise and wash hands regularly throughout the day.
- Desks and doors will be wiped during the day and the school kept well ventilated.
- All adults will wear masks where social distancing is not possible



- Staff will test 3 times a week
- If your child display's any of the 3 main symptoms of Covid 19 please arrange for a PCR test
- If your child is generally feeling under the weather they can still attend school but an LFT test is recommended
