
Thank you for your material and monetary donations for the Ukraine.

# <u>Corona Virus – the current arrangements will be in place until the Easter break. We will update you on new procedures on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> April in preparation for the return to school.</u>

- All children will be able to arrive together between 8.40am and 8.55 am. Please arrive on time so teachers on duty can return to class.
- · Drop off and pick up at the school gate, teachers will meet pupils at the front gates.
- · All children will finish school together and will be brought down to the gate at 3.20pm.
- All children will eat their lunch in the hall.
- Assembly will resume in the hall.
- · Children will need to bring their own snack.
- KS2 children need to bring in their reading books and reading records DAILY.
- · Social distancing at the school gates please and masks MUST be worn at the school gate




- · Children will be allowed to bring in a school bag however there will be no shared cloakrooms so bags will need to fit in the children's trays under their desks. They do not need pencil cases or stationary as it is all provided for them.
- PE Kits should be worn on a Monday and Forest School Clothes on a Friday.
- · Breakfast Club from 7.45am please use the hall doors for access.
- After School Club will be on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday until 5.20pm and MUST be pre booked. Collection from the hall doors please.
- · Children and staff will continue to sanitise and wash hands regularly throughout the day.
- · Desks and doors will be wiped during the day and the school kept well ventilated.
- · All adults will wear masks where social distancing is not possible.
- · Staff will test 3 times a week.
- · If your child display's any of the 3 main symptoms of Covid 19 please arrange for a PCR test
- $\cdot$  If your child is generally feeling under the weather they can still attend school but an LFT test is recommended.

# **Questionnaires**

The responses from the parental questionnaires were hugely positive, however there were a couple of questions that a few parents didn't know the answer to. Over the next few weeks I hope to address these on the newsletter. We have been addressing the children's responses in assemblies.

#### 5. Other pupils behave well in school

- At Ysgol Y Foel the behaviour of our children is one of our strongest features.
- Estyn Inspectors commented that:
- 'Nearly all pupils demonstrate respect and tolerance to each other in classes and on the
  playground. The positive interaction and strong levels of collaboration amongst pupils of
  all ages, at work and play, is a strong feature of the school. Pupils' behaviour is of a
  consistently high standard.'
- Every September the children write the school rules so they are relevant to the children in school at the time. This also means the children have a greater understanding of their meaning.
- We are a Rights Respecting School, which means that our rules and daily practises reflect
   The United Nations Rights of the child.

# **Key Stage 2 Update**


In English he children have been focusing on playscripts. Next week they will be writing their own Tudor based play.
