Our focus for the next 2 weeks will be number bonds, tally charts and graphs.

Topic

Around the World.

Our focus is on Kenya. We will be reading the books, Mama Panya's Pancakes and Handa's Surprise.

Key Stage 2

Reading- Children must bring their reading book in everyday and this includes their reading record. Please make sure you fill in their reading record at least once a week.

Year 5 and 6 will be reading Skyhawk – by Gill Lewis

Year 3 and 4 will be reading Dear Olly – by Michael Morpurgo

They will also have guided reading each week. We will be using Project X series of books and guided comprehensions for this.

Spelling – none over half term

Year 3 – 6 will be following the patterns from The Spelling Shed. They will be given spellings on Monday and will be tested on Friday. They will bring a list of spellings home to practise for that week.

They will be set an activity on The Spelling Shed (an online platform) each Monday for the children to practise their words for the week. This will need completing before their test on



Fridays. Log in details have been sent home but there are still a number of children not completing the tasks online.

Maths – For the next 2 weeks we will be focusing on telling the time, using time intervals and reading timetables.

Topic – Around The World.

Our focus will be on Africa.

Year 5 and 6

Over the next term LouNur will be working with Year 5 and 6 on being a good friend, conflict resolution, being able to lose and respect. – these are proving very popular

Year 6

As part of the New Curriculum Year 6 will be having some taster sessions in Spanish for the next half term with Mrs Sam Carson. – this has been a success so far

The children will be set homework each Monday to be returned the following Monday. This will alternate between maths and reading comprehensions.

If your child arrives before 8:15am they will be charged as per time entered on the register. If you have any queries related to charges please speak to Mrs O'Neill.

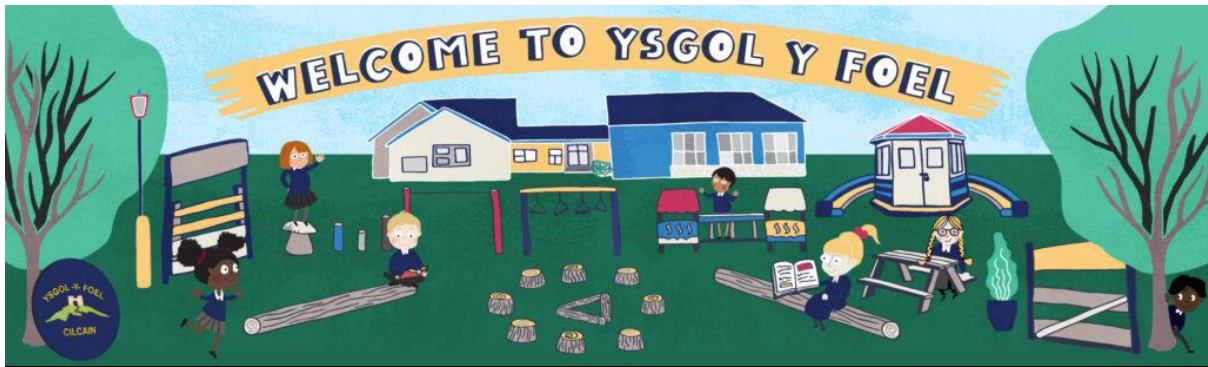
After School Club
