Breakfast Club will be invoiced on weekly basis on school gateway. A text message will be sent out on a Monday to inform you of the invoice on school gateway for the previous week.


Reminder that Breakfast club is open from:

Attendance is compulsory from Reception.


Class Information

Maths

We will begin Guided reading this term. Please ensure your child brings their reading book and reading record everyday please.

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
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Maths – After half term we will look at money.

Homework

The children will be set homework each Monday to be returned the following Monday. This will alternate between maths and literacy. This term the literacy homework focus will be on punctuation and grammar.



Year 6 pupils homework will not be returned as it is being collected as evidence. If there are a number of errors Miss Taylor will return the homework for the pupil to have another look over the activity.

Year 3 and 4 pupils need to learn their timestables, a timestable booklet has been sent home with all pupils to practice.

World Book Day


