Headteacher's Update

Welcome Back! Last week we had a really successful return to school, welcoming some new families and settling in our pupils. All of the children returned full of enthusiasm for the year ahead. We talked about our dreams and goals and our hopes for the year ahead.

I would like to say a big thank you to our PTA for the part they played in The Cilcain Show. The stall raised more much needed funds and it was lovely to catch up and hear about your holidays. This Saturday they are in action again with The Maclud Run, which promises to be a great success. The funds raised so far will be put to the refurbishment of the trim trail.

We already have lots of events lined up for this term and we have listed the dates. Our aim is to involve the community as much as possible and promote our school in the local area, so please share any events on social media far and wide.

Our school Leaders have met this week following a whole school assembly on our wishes for the year. They are made up of house captains and older children who will prioritise the children's wishes into skills, resources, experiences, clubs, sport, celebrations, eco and animals. They are currently working on a whole year plan. They will have a page on the website and they will send out event dates soon. They have chosen Cancer Research UK as their Charity for the year.

Following the success of our Forest School Session on Thursday, we have decided to make this a permanent change. Forest school on Thursday and PE on Friday. We have more staff in school on a Thursday and it will enable us to focus on some forest school specific skills such as using the tools and lighting the fire. We will also be able to have our children in wraparound care join us. The children have yet to name it!

In order to promote the use of our new wrap around care, which includes after school club, members of staff will be holding regular clubs (chosen by the children) The cost of attending will be



the cost of out of school club for a session (£7) and this will include a snack and all the resources needed for the club. Our first one will be on Monday 22nd September and will be Craft Club run by Mrs Lewis. They will be enjoying making memory boxes. We are collecting **shoe boxes** for this upcoming project, and we would greatly appreciate your help. If you have any spare shoe boxes at home please consider sending them in with your child over the next week. Payment can be made on school gateway and all children wishing to attend will need to sign up by next Friday 19th September. (Out of school club will be run as normal if your child does not want to do craft)

We are focusing on place value and the number system in Maths.


Homework

Ysgol y Foel Out of School Club

As I hope you are aware as of August 31st 2025 we are now CIW registered and as such are able to offer wraparound care for children aged 2 years to 11 years. All families received a contract at the start of term which indicated our prices for the new term. I have included these below. I am also pleased to inform all our families that if you are entitled to receive the Childcare offer for Wales or Tax Free childcare we are listed as a provider, you need to search for Ysgol y Foel Out of School Club. Ysgol Y Foel Out of School Club as a full childcare provider is a huge step for us as a school and it is our hope that as word spreads more families will use this service.

Fees are *per session* and we respectfully ask initially these are paid *weekly - in advance/by Direct Debit*.
