### **Year 6 Visit to London Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> April 2026 to Friday 24<sup>th</sup> April 2026**

We would like to take year 6 pupils to London on the 22<sup>nd</sup> April to 24<sup>th</sup> April. The proposed trip will include the list below and this is a fantastic opportunity for the children to see first-hand the images they have seen so much of on the television over the last few years, for example, the Queens Jubilee, the Queens funeral and the Coronation of King Charles III.

The trip will include –

- **2 nights bed and breakfast and packed lunch at YHA, Earls Court (with sole use of a floor)**
- **Transport by coach**
- **Tour of Parliament**
- **Paddington the Musical at The Savoy Theatre**
- **BA London Eye and River Cruise**
- **Warwick Castle**
- **Walks around the City to include - Tour of Kensington Gardens, Hyde Park, Speakers' Corner, The Mall, Buckingham Palace, Horse Guards' Parade, Westminster Abbey, Big Ben and Trafalgar Square.**

The cost of the visit to include all of the above would be **£200.00** based on all 25 pupils taking part in the visit. There may be a slight increase should the pupil numbers drop. They will also need an additional £50 pocket money for evening meals on the Wednesday and Thursday evening plus any other expenses.

We appreciate that this is well in advance but in order for us to secure the accommodation and book tickets, we need a firm decision and **£70.00 non refundable deposit by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October**. Please log in to School Gateway to pay and secure your child's place. We will set up instalments for you to pay the remaining balance. This will need to be paid in full no later than **6<sup>th</sup> February**.

As usual, we will be going with year 6 pupils from Lixwm, Caerwys, Nercwys and Nannerch Schools. This helps towards the cost of transport and provides an opportunity for the children to meet with other children, make new friendships and help prepare for transition



to High School. The children will be accompanied by a member of staff from each of the schools.
